3.	Health and Safety There have been no serious accidents or near misses since the last meeting.	
3.1	Fire Drill  Last Fire Drills were carried out as follows:  • Beavers – March 2014  • Cubs – 10/01/14  • Scouts – 10/01/14  It was noted that Fire Drills need to be carried out termly.	
4.	Moving On Beavers to Cubs: Nobody moving up until September/October. Cubs to Scouts: 4 going up this term, 1 ready to start Link now. Scouts to Explorers: 3 ready to go up.	
5. 5.1	Event Planning St George's Day Parade (Sunday 27 <sup>th</sup> April) RC noted that he would be in charge of arrangements at the Upper School playground.	
5.2	Cub Camp (Friday 2 <sup>nd</sup> May – Monday 5 <sup>th</sup> May) This event will be a Cub Camp. The Scout Camp will not be taking place.	

5.3	AGM (Friday 16 <sup>th</sup> May) CK and RC will be putting together the Agenda for the AGM. The entertainment programme is being worked on. The Best Behaved Cub needs to be decided and awards and badges will be presented.	
	Leaders will need to prepare a report and a copy should be given to RC.	Leaders
5.4	Group Camp (Saturday 24 <sup>th</sup> May – Monday 26 <sup>th</sup> May) This event will be taking place at Danemead. It was agreed that the Group should meet for van loading on Friday 23 <sup>rd</sup> May.	
5.5	Scout Summer Camp (Saturday 26 <sup>th</sup> July – Saturday 2 <sup>nd</sup> August) Eton Vale, in Norfolk, has been chosen as the venue and a visit to look at the venue will be taking place on 17 <sup>th</sup> May. The cost will be £180.	
5.6	Circuit Children's Day (Sunday 29 <sup>th</sup> June) After discussion, it was decided that the Group did not wish to get involved with this event. It was noted that there is no parallel activity planned for that day (such as Church Parade) to attract our children out in the first place.	
5.7	Group Walk for Charity (Sunday 13 <sup>th</sup> July) Discussion was held as to whether the Group wished to offer a "Church Parade Treat" / Group Outing this year. Whilst there was general enthusiasm for holding this event, with Southend the preferred choice of venue, there was also concern that this event had proved divisive in the past. It was noted that failure to attend is not always the fault of the child.	
	It was therefore agreed that a Group Walk, open to all, would be arranged after Church Parade on Sunday 13 <sup>th</sup> July as a charity event. SS will propose a suitable route.	SS
	Attendance at Church Parades was discussed further. SS commented that offering badge work at Gilwell (Communicator and Emergency Aid badges done to date) after Church Parade had proved very popular in terms of increasing attendance amongst Cubs. JS commented that the Group website states that children are "expected to attend".	
	It was agreed that it should be further discussed at the September 2014 Leaders Meeting whether to hold an event next year that is open only to children who have met the required attendance level at Church Parades. It was noted that it should be ensured, if such an event is to be held, that the criteria for attendance are clearly set out and communicated to all parents and children early in the Autumn term.	
	RC will add discussion of ways of improving attendance at Church Parades to the Agenda for the next Group Exec Meeting in June 2014.	RC
6.	Leader Team CK reported that SF would not be continuing as Assistant Cub Scout Leader after July.	
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7. 7.1	Information from Executive Committee CK reported that a trial is underway of My.SCOUT, which is Online Scout Manager's (OSM's) system for collecting payments due through a cashless system. CK has chosen 6 Scout parents, as the Scouts section has the most up-to-date records, and reports so far indicate that they like the system and are finding it easy to use.  The information for Cubs and Beavers on OSM needs to be brought up-to-date. CK will provide assistance as required.	SS / VG
7.2	The Exec has agreed that the Group's charity for the forthcoming year will be St Elizabeth's, who are currently caring for an ex-member of the Group. 7.3	Discussion was held re the level of ongoing awareness the leaders have of their sectional budget balances. The leaders were made aware of how the Exec sets the budgets and it was agreed that the existing situation whereby the Treasurer flags to the appropriate leader once their budget has been exceeded is acceptable. It was stressed that budgets are used for planning purposes only and that no leader should avoid carrying out an activity because they are worried about exceeding their budget.	
	VG would like the Group to fund a trip to the Cinema for the Beavers. RC stated that he is always happy to accompany Beaver trips if additional adult supervision is needed.
