



Fire Risk Assessment

This Scout Group has children in the age range 6 – 14.

We use the premises consisting of Bush Hill Park Methodist Church.

The Church have their own Fire Risk Assessment (FRA), approved by the church council on 7th February 2011. This is displayed on the choir vestry notice board, just before the door into the Church.

The Group's Executive Committee decided that producing our own formal FRA is neither appropriate nor necessary as we do not own or control the premises, and that we would document that we reference out to, and ensure we comply with, the Church one, instead:

- Long Vestry – Walkway must be kept clear of any obstructions as it is an Exit route.
- Kitchen – Children are normally not allowed in here, unless given specific permission and then only one at a time unless a Leader is present, and actively supervising.
- Ladies, Gents and Disabled Toilets – Electric Radiators with timers. These should not need to be turned on, off or adjusted.
- Garden Huts – It was considered that the Scouts Huts, gas cylinders etc. are all compliant.
- Fires must not be lit on the synthetic grass in the Church Garden

The 'Designated Assembly Point' – Corner of Wellington Rd. and Edenbridge Rd.
(DO NOT CROSS THE ROAD).

Each section will carry out a fire drill at least once a term.

REMEMBER –

You should only attempt to put out a fire with an extinguisher if it is safe to do so.
